A unit of work to provide students in years 4 to 7 with authentic learning contexts in which to understand and respond to litter and littering issues. The unit of work is presented as six inquiry questions, separated into three interconnected themes and delivered over 12 lessons.

Litter Less incursion

Suitable for years 4-7

The Litter Less incursion focusses on awareness, understanding and actioning of litter issues at school, in the community and the environment.

Following an introductory discussion about what litter is and how it spreads, students participate in a sample litter audit in the school grounds. After looking at the results to identify types of litter found, litter hotspots and consider bin placement, students can then develop an action plan for the school, to reduce litter.
